A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RED LODGE, MONTANA, TO RE-ESTABLISH THE RED LODGE CARNEGIE LIBRARY AS THE CITY'S FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge established many years ago a free public library currently know as the Red Lodge Carnegie Library; and


WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge desires to continue to maintain Red Lodge Carnegie Library as the city's free public library; and

WHEREAS, Section 22-1-303(1), MCA, grants the governing body of the City of Red Lodge the power to establish and maintain a free public library.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:


1. The Red Lodge Carnegie Library is hereby re-established as a free public library under the provisions of Montana laws relating to public libraries; and
2. Red Lodge Carnegie Library will continue to be operated and maintained in accordance with applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules and regulations.

PASSED and APPROVED by the Red Lodge City Council and approved by the Mayor on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2003.




