

RESOLUTION NO. 3200

A RESOLUTION BY THE RED LODGE CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION BY BEARTOOTH RESOURCE CONSERVATION & DEVELOPMENT AREA, INC. FOR A BROWNFIELDS ASSESSMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Red Lodge previously sponsored a site-specific brownfields grant application, which failed; and

WHEREAS, the City the need to conduct assessments on several sites within the City limits has been recognized for quite some time, but there was never the pressure to re-develop these properties until recent years; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the good work done by Beartooth Resource Conservation & Development Area, Inc. ("RC&D") with its previous assessment grant, and has worked with RC&D to identify the deficiencies in the City's prior grant application, has contributed to research for this grant application, and sponsored a public meeting to inform the community as a whole in support of this grant application.

NOW THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Red Lodge hereby declares its support for the Brownfields assessment grant application prepared by RC&D in the amount of \$200,000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council directs the Mayor to cooperate with RC&D in finalizing, presenting, and (assuming it is funded) implementing Brownfields assessments in support of revitalization efforts being undertaken.


