

RESOLUTION NO. 3401

A RESOLUTION OF THE RED LODGE CITY COUNCIL GRANTING A RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT TO NORTHWESTERN ENERGY FOR BURIED ELECTRIC AND GAS LINES AT THE RED LODGE AIRPORT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL ASSOCIATED DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, a "Right-of-Way Easement" between the City of Red Lodge as Grantor and Northwestern Energy as Grantee has been prepared; and

WHEREAS, said easement will allow Northwestern Energy to bury electrical and gas lines across certain portions of real property owned by the City; specifically, within the Red Lodge Airport; and

WHEREAS, granting the easement is in the best interests of the City, as it allows Northwestern Energy to conduct necessary business and provide services within the City.


