

# RESOLUTION NO. 3459

## A RESOLUTION OF THE RED LODGE CITY COUNCIL TO DEDICATE VAN DYKE PARK AS AN OFFICIAL CITY PARK WITH CONTINUED USE AS A PARK FOR OPEN SPACE AND TRAILS

**WHEREAS**, the Red Lodge City Council resolved on December 12, 2017 to approve the dedication of Van Dyke Park as recommended by the Red Lodge Parks, Trails and Recreation Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the recommendation by the Red Lodge, Parks, Trails and Recreation Board is to continue the use of the land as an open-space park with trails; and

**WHEREAS**, The Parks, Trails and Recreation Board unanimously supports making Van Dyke Park a permanent City Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Red Lodge 2015 Growth Policy, 2015 Comprehensive Parks Plan and 2016 Active Transportation Plan state the need to increase access and recreational opportunities with linear parks; and


