

Park Maintenance Needs September 6, 2016
Through-June 30, 2017

Lions Park

- *Trim trees, shrubs & remove dead branches*
- Sand & Paint garbage can near Moose Trails
- Clean grills
- Moosetrails Playground – minor maintenance as needed (add woodchips, remove caps on posts and add wood sealant, fix music organ, remove graffiti, tighten bolts on swings)
- Sand and coat Picnic Table
- Repair volleyball Net support poles; dig & pour concrete
- Rebuild the 8 pedestals for the gazebo, caulk & paint other portions

Rotary Park

- *Trim trees along southern fence; causing fence damage*
- *Tree trimming 10-12 feet*
- Clean grills
- Paint support posts for signage

Finn Park

- *Trim trees up to 10-12 feet*
- *Remove dead branches & debris*
- Clean grill

Coal Miner's Park

- *Trim trees as needed (along parking lot & Memorial)*
- Remove fences around Memorial
- Memorial Park: Assess needs & general maintenance
- Create diagram/instructions for irrigation system
- Weed whack areas around picnic tables and access sites along Rock Creek
- Remove "City Park daylight use only" sign from fence on south end of football field.
- Refurbish rocky fork trail sign near football field.
- Refurbish Coal Miner's Park sign. Move to north side of street. Could probably see if the High School and/or wildlife sanctuary would like to contribute toward the sign and put their names on it as well.
- Remove dead trees across the street from Coal Miner's Park sign.
- Move Frisbee golf course bulletin board to the north toward bottom of bike trail switchback. The intent is to get the bulletin board so it is not at the base of the hill that kids sled down. A little girl hit this on her sled a few years ago and broke her leg. Add another panel to the bulletin board and include info on it about trails and coal miner's memorial.

- Install sign directing park users up the stairs to coal miner's park memorial.
- Finish removing chain link cross-fence in northernmost portion of park. MCC removed a much of the chain link. Barbed wire and posts still need removed across entire length of fence. Some sections of chain link also still remain. Would need to rent a piece of equipment to remove the posts or get Jim Bushnell and public works to do that part.
- Purchase native grass seed mix and seed exposed dirt in area between Beartooth Lane and wildlife sanctuary fence. Spread light layer of weed free straw or other mulch after seeding completed. Ideally, we should get the seeding done after it frosts this fall (Dan Siefert can recommend seed mix and seeding rate).
- Install a treated 4X4" posts at each trail junction for placement of trail signs (trail sign design is pending with ATP, but we could get the posts in place this fall).

Pride Park

- Install Broadway Ave historic sign
- possibly trim trees

Skate Park

- Fix Fence
- Mow weeds

Field School Park

- Fix fencing along the eastern portion of the tennis court
- Minor tree trimming
- Add wood chips in playground

Dog Park

- *Remove dead trees*
- *Trim small trees, particularly along the west ditch*
- *Facilitate burn pile*

Pool

- *Trim all trees; particularly those on northern and western boulevards*

General Park/Trail/Tree Needs

- *Trim recently planted trees along Broadway (Beartooth Lane to 14th)*
- Sand & paint garbage can at Rocky Fork shelter
- Power wash garbage cans
- Get signs installed at trail/street junctions. Need a "No Motorized Vehicle" sign facing the cross-streets. Need "Yield" signs for trail users where trails meet cross-streets. I think these are the relevant standards, but we just want post-mounted signs (not overhead signs):

- Secure park benches as needed

Corner Park:

- If we mow and service the park:
- Install dog-doo station.
- Install garbage can that allied waste can service.
- Install "City Park" sign.
