

## **Red Lodge Parks, Trees and Recreation Board**

### **Trails Committee report-November 2016**

Committee members: Corey Thompson, Paul Otsu, and Kelly Heaton.

The committee did not meet, but City Staff, committee members, and other Parks board members coordinated so as to complete several tasks, including the following:

- 1. Creekside Park:** Jim Stevenson is expected to start trail work at Rotary Park during the week of November 14<sup>th</sup>. The trail has been flagged and large branches/obstacles were removed by MCC in October. Additional work is expected to cost less than \$600.
- 2. Rotary Park:** The new trail at Rotary Park has had additional work completed. Leftover road mix was spread on the old road section of the trail. Rotary volunteers and staff completed the work. There is still the need to add boulder/signs at new trailheads to prevent motorized vehicles on trails
- 3. Coal Miners Park:** Public Works needs rocks removed from the edges of new trails, particularly on top, towards the high school. Public works will not mow the areas next summer because of the rocks. They indicated that they have spent years flattening the land and removing rocks in order to mow the area.
