

Cemetery Board Minutes: May 10, 2016

Meeting called to order at 5:17pm at Red Lodge City Hall by Dan Gainer

Jim Bushnell reported that spraying the weeds before mowing will provide a better kill on the weeds. The grave settling has continued, with more having settled than the previous month. The majority of the settling is occurring in the 40 year old graves. Public Works will continue to fill and repair as they have time. There has been one painter that responded to look at the mausoleum and will be providing us with an estimate. There is painting near the roof that will need to be done before work on the roof can begin.

Dan Gainer, Bert Douthit and Jim attended the commissioners meeting on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Dan read the article that he has prepared for the newspaper and will forward it to Bill Foisy to have him send it out on google group, Facebook, and the city website.

The committee will need to prepare a fact sheet and an introduction letter to list of potential voters in the proposed district. It will include information on the maintenance requirements, mils proposed, cost per household. Dan will work on a draft and email it to the committee members before the next commissioner's public hearing on the proposed district.

Dan did some research on how the City came into possession of the cemetery and provided the committee with a document that shows the property was sold for \$1 in 1894 by the MacDonald's when the county was still Park County.

There was no communication from the public.

Meeting was adjourned at 5:55pm. The next scheduled meeting will be June 14th at 5pm.
