
The Red Lodge City Council met for a working session on September 10, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.


Members Present: Mayor Larson, Aldermen Cameron, Dimich, Hoffman, Mahan, Weamer, and Westwood.

The items the Mayor, City Council, Public, and Staff discussed were the following:

1. Resolution #3527, Land Use Permit Application – Council agreed to combine the two resolutions that were presented and move forward with it.
2. Resolution #3528, Authorizing Issuance of Sale of Bonds – Council agreed to move forward with this, but within the motion for approval add pending the City Attorney’s approval.
3. Resolution #3530, Transfer of Funds to General Fund Reserves- Council discussed changing the dollar amounts of \$6,000 to \$15,000. Council agreed to move forward with changes.
4. Soccer Field- James Caniglia said DEQ received the bids for the soccer field and they came in way over what was budgeted and DEQ will not fund the project. He said the Soccer Group is working with Seth Berglee to take it to the legislatures.
5. Pool Update- Mayor Larson said Brent Moore, Interstate Engineering, is working on the options for financing of the new pool and getting the survey done. Larson said Brent will be bringing to the Council a presentation on the different options for funding.
6. 8:00 p.m. end time for work sessions and minutes of work sessions- Council discussed making motions to extend the time of work sessions if agenda items still need to be discussed.
