Discussion Items

Ad hoc per public comment: Bee City Application and Draft Resolution

Courtney would like the City of Red Lodge to apply for Bee City Status and first steps require submission of an application containing a draft resolution. The template for a Bee City resolution is available to the Board for review with some of the mark-ups added by Courtney to indicate year, city, other standard items.

Application fee is \$100 annually along with a report stating what the City did to fulfill requirements

Board will review the draft (Sec. sending with "homework" items), consider fit with Parks Board (possibly "Tree and Bee Committee" should the City move ahead with seeking Bee City status).

Will be added as Discussion item for next meeting.

2. Skate Park upgrades

Kevin has been discussing with Evergreen Skate Parks a visit to Red Lodge for an evaluation of the current site and situation relative to improvements for the Skate Park.

- Based on Evergreen's evaluation and proposed Design for a Park in the existing space, Parks Board could submit the proposed/upgraded Skate Park as a capital improvement project to the City.
- This may not require City funds if the interested party's kick-starter raises enough money for the improvements project. There are already some funds available to the CIP for the Skate Park: 2019/2020 budget, RLACF fund and other donations
- Former resident of Red Lodge has large following among skate community and is interested in fundraising via Kick-start for a better Skate Park in Red Lodge.
- Aim is for construction next summer concurrent and/or in sequence with project at Crow Agency Kevin will check on dates for Evergreen's visit to Red Lodge

3. Arbor Day Tree Planting

All is set for 9/27 (any weather) at the north side of Carnegie Library. Baldwin's is delivering and seating the tree due to size of root and ball. Will leave dirt aside for planting participants to add and complete planting. Mayor scheduled to attend, advertised on facebook, posters, email to sustainability group, school dist., etc. Activity related to Blue Spruce planting planned and all other Arbor Day activities were conducted at Earth Day Parks Board Tables (children's tree books, public trees map and soliciting recommendations for arbor day sites, Mayor's proclamation, etc.)

4. User group MOU annual review language - discussion

Board approved wording for addition to MOUs - all in favor 7/0

There is an idea that the City may want to partner with the High School District to build this pool with the City's role being maintenance or help staff it during off hours or Summer months when school is not using it and the public wants to.
