The Red Lodge City Council met for a working session on October 8, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Members Present: Mayor Larson, Aldermen Cameron, Dimich, Hoffman, Mahan, Weamer, and Westwood.

The items the Mayor, City Council, Public, and Staff discussed were the following:

1. Resolution #3533- Amended and Restated Bond- City Clerk, Loni Hanson, went over the Resolution #3533 and Resolution #3531 regarding the refinancing of the Water Bonds. She said the Council will need to amend both of these resolutions to switch the numbers around. The Amended and Restated Bond resolution needs to be approved before the Bid is awarded.
2. Resolution #3531, Award Bond Bid- Loni Hanson said that DA Davidson won the bid award. She said the City will be saving close to 2.2 million dollars and we will cut the length of payments by ten years.
3. Pool Update- Mark Brajich talked to the Council about the idea of joining with the School District to build a pool.
4. Use of City Owned Land- Christmas Stroll- Sherry Weamer, Chamber of Commerce, went over the plan for Christmas Stroll this year. Dimich had concerns about non-profits that were serving alcohol last year and the open container ordinance is still in effect and businesses need to know that people cannot walk out in the streets with open containers.
